- Fr. Nemeh Farah was born in the Al-Waraideh Village East of Homs on 1/1/1926
  - He moved to the Village of Fhaileh with his parents when he was 6 years of age.
  - He attended Church services regularly from his childhood, and was ordained a Deacon in St. Elian Church in the Village of Fhaileh.
  - He married to Mrs. Hadwa Chahla daughter of Khalil Chahla, the alderman of Fhaileh.
  - He has five children: Riam, Siham, Hiyam, Issa and Ghassan.
  - His deceased brothers: Abdullah, George, Elian, Mtanos.
  - His deceased sister: Nadwa.
  - He was ordained a priest in the Church of Virgin Mary the Mother of the Girdle in Homs in 1952. The late patriarch Mor Ignatius Aphrem I Barsom officiated at the ceremony of his ordination. He served St. George Church of Zaydal until 1979.
  - He immigrated to the US in 1979, and was appointed in 1982 to serve St. Ephrim Church as a pastor. He served until 1986.
  - He was appointed to serve St. George Church established during the time of his service in 1987. He served the Church until 1994.
  - His Holiness Patriarch Mor Ignatius Zaka I Iwas bestowed upon him the Holy Cross. His Eminence Mor Clemus Eugene Kaplan decorated him with the Cross on 5/2/1999
